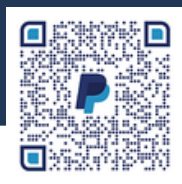

## CHHC IS MOVING!

In 2020, the Community of Hope Health Clinic took a leap of faith by moving to 2692 Pelham Parkway (next to Pee Wee's Pawn Shop). Within six months of moving, it was obvious that CHHC would need to find a new place to house all of the services offered.

Since opening on Hwy 31 in Pelham, CHHC has expanded to include Physical Therapy, Mental Health, Prenatal, Dermatology, and now an on-site medication dispensary.

"When COVID-19 shut the world down, we didn't know how that would affect us," Executive Director, Justin Johnston said. "While most individuals and businesses saw a decrease in business and service, we had the complete opposite. Once we started administering vaccines, it was obvious to me that eventually we would need to find a bigger space to accommodate what we offer."

CHHC HOPES TO MOVE INTO ITS NEW SPACE BY MID-JULY

Johnston said that he was cleaning up some of the clinic one day and noticed a real estate sign out back in the building behind where CHHC is currently housed.

"I knew that if we were able to get the right price for that place, we could move there and it would be a good thing," Johnston said. "Maria Fernanda (Operations Director), Rick (Medical Director), and I took a tour and everything seem to be what we needed."

The property is located at 1970 Chandalar Office Park in Pelham and CHHC hopes to open there by mid-July. Once the clinic is settled in, Johnston said that he hopes to have an open-house where everyone can come to see what services are offered and how the new clinic helps CHHC offer them.
