# **Pray for CHHC**



## Community – Philippians 2:2-5; 2 Corinthians 8:3-5

- Then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind. Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others. In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus. Philippians 2:2-5 (NIV)
  - Pray for leadership and volunteers to be united in love and service through Christ Jesus to the Shelby County community. Pray for partnerships with like-minded individuals and organizations that will further assist CHHC with fulfilling its mission.
- For I testify that they gave as much as they were able, and even beyond their ability. Entirely on their own, they urgently pleaded with us for the privilege of sharing in this service to the Lord's people. And they exceeded our expectations: They gave themselves first of all to the Lord, and then by the will of God also to us. 2 Corinthians 8:3-5 (NIV)
  - Pray for people to give generously of their time and resources to enable CHHC to continue to provide healthcare to our community members in need.

## Hope - Acts 2:21-28; 2 Corinthians 4:16-18

- And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.' "Fellow Israelites, listen to this: Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by God to you by miracles, wonders and signs, which God did among you through him, as you yourselves know. This man was handed over to you by God's deliberate plan and foreknowledge; and you, with the help of wicked men, put him to death by nailing him to the cross. But God raised him from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him. David said about him: 'I saw the Lord always before me. Because he is at my right hand, I will not be shaken. Therefore my heart is glad and my tongue rejoices; my body also will rest in hope, because you will not abandon me to the realm of the dead, you will not let your holy one see decay. You have made known to me the paths of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence.' Acts 2:21-28 (NIV)
  - Pray for each person who comes to CHHC to be encouraged by the hope of the gospel. Pray that
    many will "call on the name of the Lord and be saved" because of this ministry.
- Therefore, we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal. 2 Corinthians 4:16-18 (NIV)
  - Pray for spiritual renewal in the lives of those who come to CHHC. May we be encouraging and help one another as we face temporary physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual battles here on this earth.

## Health - Psalm 121:1-2; James 5:13-16

- I lift up my eyes to the mountains— where does my help come from?

  My help comes from the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth. Psalm 121:1-2 (NIV)
  - Pray that we would look to our Creator as the source of life and healing. Pray that He would give our medical providers the knowledge and wisdom needed to provide quality health care to those in need.
- Is anyone among you in trouble? Let them pray. Is anyone happy? Let them sing songs of praise. Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven. James 5:13-16 (NIV)
  - Pray that CHHC can continue to provide quality health care and healing in the name of Jesus Christ for the mind, body, and soul.

#### Clinic - Matthew 9:35-38

- Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness. When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field." Matthew 9:35-38 (NIV)
  - Thank God for the CHHC leadership and volunteers. Pray that He will continue to send godly workers who will follow the example of Jesus to show compassion through healing, teaching, and the proclamation of the gospel.

#### What is the gospel?

Gospel = Good News!

"The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart," that is, the message concerning faith that we proclaim: If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved. As Scripture says, "Anyone who believes in him will never be put to shame." For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!" Romans 10:8-15 (NIV)
